Information shared at this event is likely to be valuable to land managers/crofters applying to any future agri-environment schemes.

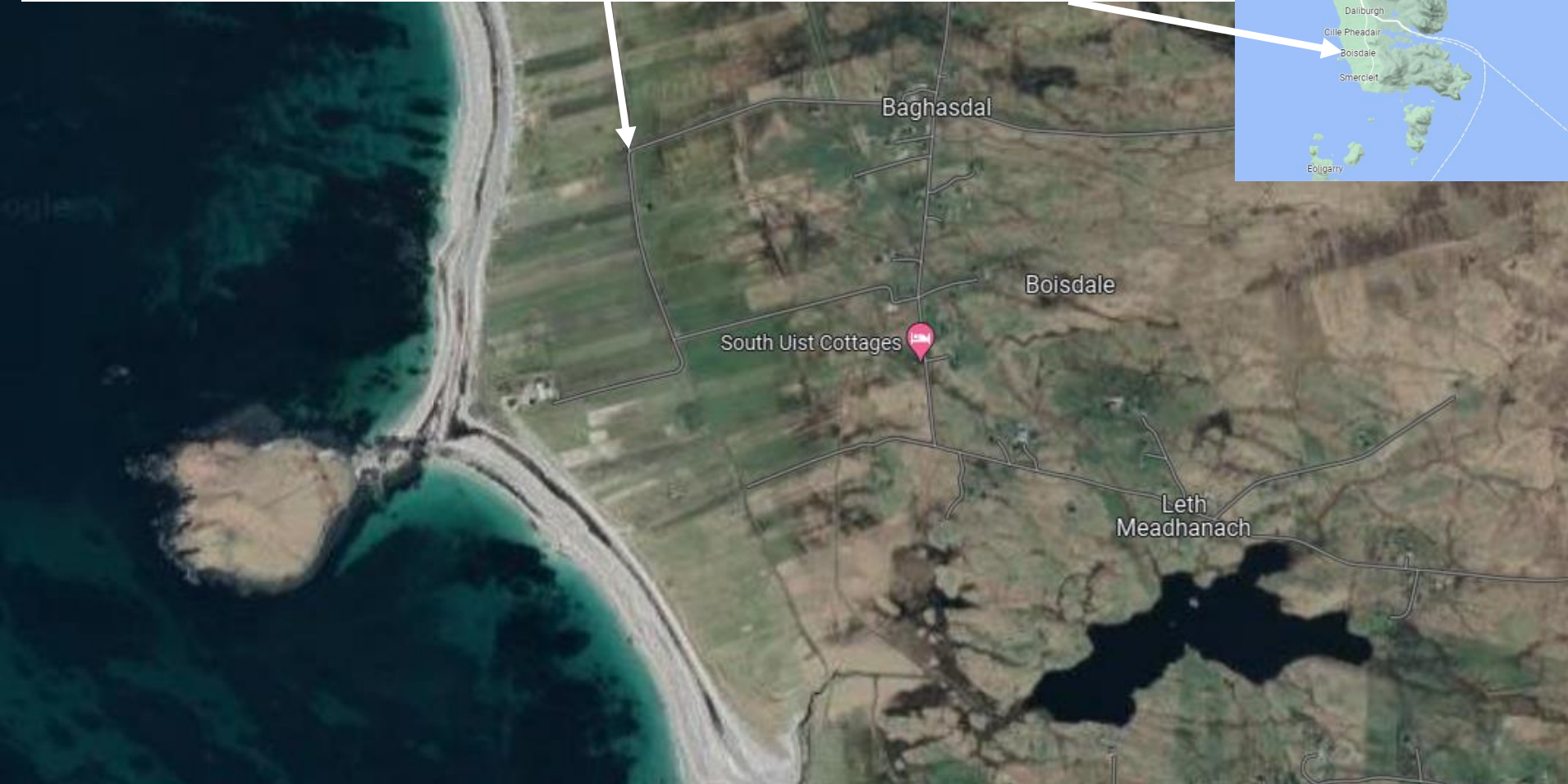
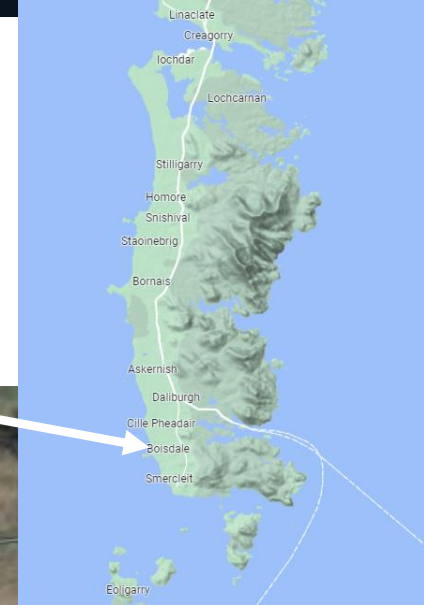
