Take part in the Cricklade North Meadow BioBlitz

Cricklade Court Leet are holding a BioBlitz on North Meadow National Nature Reserve with our partners Natural England and the Floodplain Meadows Partnership.

We aim to record as many species of plants and animals as possible on North Meadow between 18th May and 1st June. During these 2 weeks species specialists will be carrying out surveys but anyone can help by recording what you see.

We are doing this to enable everyone to learn more about the rare and special habitat of North Meadow and to provide invaluable records about what lives there to inform its conservation.

On Saturday 1st June there will be an event in Cricklade Town Hall where you can talk to species specialists about what has been found. There will be stands from Natural England, The Floodplain Meadows Partnership, Cricklade Court Leet, Fritillary Botanical Art and a range of species specialists covering plants, birds, butterflies, moths, flies, beetles, mammals, dragonflies, and damselflies. There will be a series of talks, activities for children and refreshments.

New to species recording? How to take part

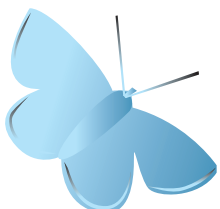
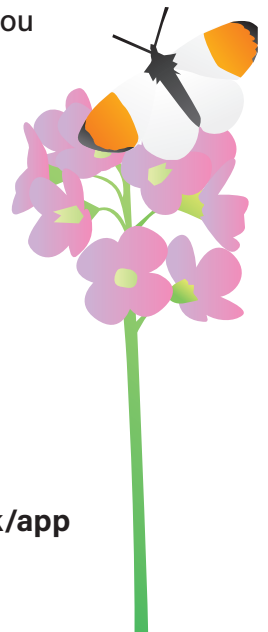
We want as many people as possible to take part in sending in species records you don't need any prior knowledge you can learn as you take part. A species record consists of four bits of information:

1. What did you see?
2. When did you see it?
3. Where did you see it?
4. Who saw it?



If you are new to species recording, we want you to use your mobile phone and an application called iRecord App. When you install and sign in the iRecord App it will help you to identify and send in your records. Take a photograph and enter what you have seen with the help of the App. When, Where and Who will be automatically recorded for you.

We have set up a special project on iRecord called North Meadow BioBlitz which will enable you to see what everyone else is recording. When you have installed the App make sure you join our project. If you need help go to the Cricklade Court Leet website.
